## RIVERWORKS Gallery in Greenville, SC, Offers Student Art Exhibition

RIVERWORKS Gallery in Greenville, SC, will present *26 Awards*, an exhibition of the award winners from the "2016 Department of Visual Art Annual Student Exhibition" at Greenville Technical College, on view from Feb. 3 - 19, 2017. A reception will be held on Feb. 3, from 6-9pm.

The "2016 DVA Annual Student Exhibition" marks the culmination of a year of studio work by recognizing the best works created by Greenville Technical College's visual and applied art students. A record 194 entries were submitted by 57 Visual Arts students, 18 of whom received awards. Award donations totaling \$2,000 were shared among the award winners, with \$200 going to Best in Show, Tiffany Dodd's photograph, "Peyton 071916".

The exhibition represents the many courses of study offered by the Visual Arts Department with entries submitted in various categories including photography, web design, graphic design, sculpture, printmaking, painting, drawing, and design and color. According to Shane Howell, Head of the Department of Visual Arts, "26 Awards encourages our students and provides them a professional venue to celebrate their talents. *26 Awards* also offers the public the opportunity to enjoy the best of the best from Greenville Technical College's Department of Visual Arts."
