

Greenville County Museum of Art in Greenville, SC, Features Works from the Johnson Collection

The Greenville County Museum of Art in Greenville, SC, is presenting *Romantic Spirits: Nineteenth Century Paintings from the Johnson Collection*, on view through May 31, 2015. On May 3, at 2pm, Lauren Brunk, vice president of Brunk Auctions in Asheville, NC, a former Winterthur fellow, and a past curator of the Johnson Collection, will present a free gallery talk as part of the museum's Sundays at 2 programming, offering museumgoers a glimpse inside this exhibition of works that reflects the American South.

The exhibition invites viewers to consider romanticism as it developed between 1810 and 1896 in the South. The exhibition, which includes paintings by Gustave Henry Mosler, Thomas Addison Richards, Joseph Rusling Meeker, Robert Walter Weir, and




"The Burial of Latané," 1864 by William Dickinson Washington (1831-1870), oil on canvas
