

the Pickens County (SC) Museum of Art and History, the Anderson (SC) Arts Center and the Durham (NC) Art Guild. Cummings holds an MFA and a Graduate Certificate in Museum Studies from the University of Cincinnati in Ohio and a BFA from Kendal College. She also studied at the Studio Arts Center International in Florence, Italy.

The 701 CCA Prize's purpose is to identify and recognize young South Carolina artists whose work is exemplary in its originality, shows awareness of artistic developments and is of high artistic merit. "All three finalists easily matched the criteria," board chair Roefs said, "as did many of the artists who submitted a portfolio for the judge's consideration but didn't make it to the finals." This year's

installment was the third 701 CCA Prize event.

"With the 701 CCA Prize, 701 Center for Contemporary Art has added a crucial component to the eco-system for artists and the visual arts in South Carolina," Roefs said. "Prior to this 701 CCA initiative, the state did not have a prominent event to highlight the best young talent in South Carolina."

This solo exhibition will feature work created throughout the duration of Cummings' residency that explores themes outlined in detail above. The show will be comprised of two-dimensional paintings and installations.
