at the University of South Carolina, Columbia College, Anderson Ranch, Arrowmont School of Arts & Crafts and Penland School of Arts & Crafts. She also takes painting classes from artist Frances Nelson. Swanson is represented by Camellia Art Gallery in Hilton Head Island, SC, and Art & Light Gallery in Greenville, SC, and sells work out of SRO in Charleston.

Swanson won first place in the Mixed Media Division at the SC State Fair in 2013 and 2015. Her paintings have also been accepted into the *Carolina's Got Art* competition in 2013 and ArtFields in 2016. She was one of three artists featured in the September 2014 *Columbia Metropolitan Magazine* and was featured in Greenville's *Town Magazine* in 2015.
