Still Hopes Retirement Community, in West Columbia, SC, is the host venue for the *Trenholm Artists Guild Summer Juried Show and Sale*. The exhibit will be on display from Aug. 6 through Sept. 28, 2018, in the Marshall A. Shearouse Wellness Center Gallery. The opening reception and award ceremony will be held on Aug. 9, from 6-8pm. The reception will also feature jewelry and pottery by TAG members. Hallie Bertling of Greenville, SC, will judge the show.

The show will include approximately sixty two-dimensional art pieces created by many renowned midlands-area artists. Joong Bae Kim won the 2017 Best of Still Hopes Show award. Other recent top award winners of TAG's juried shows are Dale Bishop, Pete Holland, Mark Conrardy, and J. Michael McGuirt.

The Trenholm Artists Guild, also known as TAG, has a membership of 200. The

group includes both amateur and professional artists who work in all media.

Established in 1971, TAG is an incorporated, non-profit organization located in Columbia, South Carolina. It is designated an IRS 501 (c) (3) organization.
